To examinees planning to take the Tokushima University entrance examination:

Re: Tokushima University's Response to the Novel Coronavirus Infection (COVID-19) in the Selection of Applicants

We would like to ask all examinees to take the following precautions when taking the entrance examination. If you have any questions, please contact Tokushima University.

- Please take care to prevent infection on a daily basis, and take your body temperature in the morning to check for any changes in your physical condition.
- 2. Students who have a fever, cough, or other symptoms for about one week before the examination date should see a doctor in advance of the examination.
- 3. Those who are infected with a novel coronavirus infection (COVID-19) and are hospitalized or are recuperating at home or in an accommodation on the day of the examination are not allowed to take the examination.

Those who are asymptomatic without fever, cough, or other conditions may be qualified to take the examination, so please ask Tokushima University for more information.

- 4. On the day of the examination, please be aware of the following:
 - •Always wear a mask, except when eating lunch.
 - •If for some reason it is difficult for you to wear a mask, please consult with the university in advance.
 - You may be asked to remove your mask when the proctor checks your identity.

- Doors and windows will be opened frequently in order to ventilate the examination room, so please consider what to wear.
- Disinfect your hands with alcohol when entering and exiting the examination room.
- •When you eat lunch, please eat quietly at your own seat.
- •Refrain from contacting or talking with others during breaks and lunch as much as possible.
- •If you have a fever, cough, or other symptoms, do not take the examination if your temperature is 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher on the day of the examination.
- •If you feel unwell, inform a proctor or other staff.
- 5. A temperature check will be conducted at the entrance of the examination site, but if you are suspected of having a fever or if you report that you are feeling ill, a doctor will check your symptoms at Tokushima University Campus Life Health Support Center. If you have at least one of the symptoms in **Group A** or two or more of the symptoms in **Group B**, you will not be allowed to take the examination in order to ensure the safety of yourself, other examinees, and the proctors.

Group A

- ① High fever (38.0 degrees or higher)
- 2 Shortness of breath (dyspnea)
- 3 Strong fatique

Group B

- ① Fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, and less than 38.0 degrees
- 2 Coughing
- ③ Sore throat
