### INFORMATION FOR AUTHORS

The Journal of Oral Health and Biosciences is published by Tokushima University Faculty of Dentistry for the issue of reviews, original articles, thesis, clinical case reports and reports in dentistry and the related areas. Authors submitting a paper do so on the understanding that the work has not been published before, is not being considered for publication elsewhere and has been read and approved by all authors. Basically, the submission of manuscripts is limited to members of the Shikoku Society of Dental Research.

All human investigations must be conducted according to the principles expressed in the Declaration of Helsinki. All human studies need ethical committee approval and the authors need to write the approval number in the manuscript. All studies involving animals must state that guidelines for the use and care of laboratory animals of the authors' institution or any national law were followed.

Submit manuscripts on white A4 paper with 3 cm margin in each side with double-space and provide a copy of the manuscript on a new CD formatted in text style. Figures and tables must accompany the disk. Mark a special character such as italic, bold, subscript, superscript, Greek letters, mathematical symbols et al. The printed manuscript and the file on the disk must be the same. Label the disk clearly with the authors' names and file content.

The paper should be submitted in English or Japanese. Sections of the manuscripts should be organized and numbered consecutively as follows: Title page, Abstract, Introduction, Patients and methods / Materials and methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgements, Reference list, Figure legends, Figures, and Tables. Manuscripts should be carefully revised before submission. Manuscripts should be checked by a native speaker of English. In some cases, an English certificate might be required.

The title page should contain the: title, author name(s), department(s) / institution(s) to which the work is attributed, key words (3-5 words), category (original article, thesis, case report, review article etc.), page numbers of text bodies, figures and tables, request numbers for offprints, and name, address, telephone and fax numbers of the author to whom correspondence about the manuscript should be referred.

The abstract must not exceed 400 words and should state the purpose of the study, basic procedures (study subject / patients / animals and methods), main findings, and principal conclusions. Use terms from the Medical Subject Headings list from Index Medicus, whenever possible.

Drawings and charts for reproduction should be made in black and laser quality. Photographs (maximum 17 cm in width x 22 cm in length) and drawings should be numbered on the back. Color illustrations are acceptable; however, the author(s) are requested to pay the extra cost/s. Author (s) should indicate the appropriate position of the text figures and tables on the manuscripts. Abbreviations should conform to the style accepted in the Japanese Medical Sciences and used in the Quarterly Cumulative Index Medicus.

Number references consecutively in the order in which they are first mentioned in the text. Identify references in text, tables and legends by Arabic numerals (in parentheses). All references cited, and only these, must be listed at the end of the paper. All authors' names should be described. Abbreviations of journals must conform to those used in Index Medicus of the National Library of Medicine. The format should conform to the examples listed below:

Acknowledge persons and grant sources that have made substantive contributions to the study

There will be a charge of approximately \$50.00 per printed page. As a general rule, papers will be evaluated by two independent reviewers. Authors can indicate their recommended referees. Revised manuscripts should be accompanied by a point-by-point reply to the recommendations of the reviewers and editor, specifying the changes made in the revised version. When the manuscript is accepted for publication, the authors must agree to automatically transfer the copyright to the Journal of Oral Health and Biosciences.
